

A New Sankara Nethralaya in Andhra Pradesh

Sankara Nethralaya would soon be making its presence in the Tamil Nadu-AP border at Nellore District. The proposed eye care facility will be inaugurated at the Sri City Special Economic Zone, Sulurpeta, on the auspicious occasion of Tamil New Year on 14th April 2013. The MoU for the joint initiative was signed by Shri Ravindra Sanna Reddy, MD, Sri City and Dr S.Bhaskaran, Chairman, Sankara Nethralaya on 5th December 2012. Speaking on the occasion Shri Ravindra Sanna Reddy observed that it would be Sri City's initiative to provide healthcare to the locals in addition to local employment through industrial support. The hospital would provide both in-patient and outpatient care and function on a small scale similar to the Sri Srinivasa Sankara Nethralaya, Tirupati and the RS Falor Hospital, Rameswaram.

It was a great honour for India, a testimony to the expertise of Sankara Nethralaya's optometrists when the World Blind Cricket Council (WBCC) appointed a team of optometrists from Sankara Nethralaya to select the Blind Cricket team for the League matches and the World Cup match. The optometrists selected the team by applying the guidelines prescribed by the SBCC to the last detail, the selection process involved calculating of Functional Acuity Score (FAS) and Functional Field Score (FVS). In another instance demonstrating the trust of the government in the expertise of the LVC the State Commissioner for the differently abled invited Ms.G.Sarika, Head, Low Vision clinic to finalize the vision aids to be provided by the government to the visually disabled. A demonstration of the electronic devices currently available and used by patients with different low vision complaints, made by Ms. Sarika, led to a better understanding of their functionalities and advantages, helping the members to finalize the same.
